Characteristics: Austria's showcase grape variety shows itself here in a strong ruby-garnet colour with a violet reflection. The nose shows subtle spiciness, fine berry fruit - mainly blackberry - and a slight floral scent as well as some liquorice and hibiscus notes. There is juicy, cool fruit on the palate coated by robust, firm tannins, ripe berry fruit and a mineral finish. Great potential for development.

Origin: Vines up to 25 years old growing in the Alter Berg vineyard site on the slope of the Leithagebirge. The fossil-rich limestone soil deposits a lively minerality to this wine.

Vinification: Harvested by hand on the 9th and 10th of October 2008 at 20° KMW; meticulous selection, first in the vineyard and then again on the winery sorting belt. Processed according to the gravity principle (without the use of pumps); spontaneous fermentation in oak vats, manual submerging of the must; 4 to 5 weeks of maceration and malolactic fermentation, and 18 months of maturing in 500-litre barrels. Bottled with glass closures at the beginning of May 2010.
