CHARACTER

The vintage character is aptly displayed with cool floral notes, vibrancy, and subtle mineral notes. Bing and amarelle cherry with ripe blackberry, leafy spice and lovage on the nose. Fine-boned tannin structure and juicy acidity exude elegance all the way through the finish.

ORIGIN

The harmonious amalgamation of two worlds – the east and west side of Lake Neusiedl. This autochthon variety is exemplary for Burgenland and feels just as comfortable in the limestone and slate of the Leitha Mountains as it does on the sandy loam on the south escarpment of the Parndorf Plain.

PRODUCTION

Bottled with conscientious handcraft and great care throughout the entire life cycle. Organic cultivation of the vineyards. Hand picked mid-October 2013, spontaneous fermentation with two weeks maceration in the wooden fermentation vats and steel tanks. Matured for 9 months in used barriques and 500-litre oak barrels.
