CHARACTER

Red berried, spicy and floral – straight, typical Blaufränkisch. Youthful, juicy, robust, refreshing and invigorating. And despite this, at its core, serious, substantial, concentrated and lively, not even to speak of the pronounced salty-mineral finish.

ROOTS

The harmonious unification of two worlds: the east and west side of the Neusiedler See (Lake Neusiedl). The autochthone, quint-essential variety of Burgenland feels just as much at home in the limestone and schist sites of the Leithaberg (Leitha Mountains) as it does in the sandy, loamy south-facing slopes of the Parndorfer Platte (Parndorfer Plain).

GENESIS

Bottled with conscientious handcraft and great care throughout the entire life cycle. Organic cultivation of the vineyards, manual harvest beginning of October 2014, spontaneous fermentation, maceration for two weeks in wooden fermentation vat and steel tank, maturation for 9 months in and used 225-litre and 500-litre oak barrels.
