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Characteristics: Medium green-yellow. The nose exhibits pronounced yellow plum and melon with nuances of lime and fresh herbs. Juicy acidity is harmoniously balanced with sweetly extracted fruit in an elegant, satiny texture. Salty minerals linger on the vibrant finish.

Origin: This Chardonnay stems from an east-facing slope of the Leithag-ebirge with limestone and slate soils. A first class vintage marked by a hot, dry summer led to perfect ripening of the grapes and enhanced mineral character.

Vinification: Harvested by hand mid-September 2012 at 21°KMW (25° Brix). Manual selection in the vineyard, gentle pressing and movement of the must by gravity while abstaining from the use of pumps. Spontaneous fermentation and malolactic fermentation followed by 11-months maturation on the lees in 500-litre oak barrels. Bottled at the end of August 2013.
