Characteristics: Dark ruby red with a deep dark core. The nose exhibits rich aromas of elderberry and blackberry with ethereal nuances layered with dark spice. Amarelle and Bing cherry flavour fine-grained tannins and a firm spine of acid. The finish features nuances of dark chocolate and vibrant freshness.

Origin: Up to 35-year-old vines in the Pannobile sites (Salzberg, Gabarinza, Ungerberg, Altenberg, Kurzberg, Kaiserberg and Alter Aussatz) on the south-facing escarpment of the Parndorf Plateau. Sedimented, calcareous gravel-sand-loam soils.

Vinification: Manual harvest mid-September to the beginning of October 2011. Hand selection in the vineyard followed by sorting in the winery. Movement of grapes and must occurs by gravitation without the use of pumps. Spontaneous fermentation in oak vats with manual punch down, three weeks maceration, spontaneous malolactic fermentation and 20 months maturation in used 500-litre and 225-litre oak barrels. Bottled at the end of August 2013.
