CHARACTER

Deep ruby with purple highlights. Minimalistic and reduced to the essential. Provides abundant drinking pleasure. Cool, red berried, peppered and plenty of cherry says the nose. Subtle and refreshing, playful and fruity completes the palate. Impressive, juicy and soft texture. Not too much alcohol, taut acidity and fine-boned tannin. Unique and easy-drinking!

ORIGIN

“red” is sourced from both sides of Lake Neusiedl. Vines on the west side are rooted in the limestone and schist of the Leithaberg slopes. On the east side of the lake grapes benefit from the gravelly *Parndorf Plateau* and the humus-rich *Heideboden*.

PRODUCTION

Bottled with conscientious handcraft and great care throughout the entire life cycle. Vineyards are currently being converted to organic cultivation. Manually harvested mid September. Spontaneous fermentation with two weeks maceration in wooden and stainless steel vats, matured for 12 months in big wooden casks and used 500-litre oak barrels.
