**Characteristics:** Deep, dark ruby-garnet hue – opaque with a violet reflection. Scents of tobacco and herbs, blackberry and blueberry, light floral components and black pepper. The palate features fresh mineral tones and notes of red berries, cherry and orange zest. Silky tannins, vibrant acidity and a dark berry finish.

**Origin:** The grapes for this wine come from both sides of the Neusiedlersee. On one side of the lake is the Rosenberg vineyard site - an eastern slope in Breitenbrunn am Leithagebirge dominated by mica-slate soils. On the other side of the lake, to the east, are vineyards on the gravelly Parndorfer Platte and the humus-rich Heideboden.

**Vinification:** Harvested by hand at the beginning of September 2011. Following selection in the vineyards and then on the winery sorting belt, processing according to the gravity principle without pumps took place. Spontaneous fermentation in steel tanks and wooden vats. After stirring via the Pulsair system, there were three weeks of maceration and 10 months of maturation in used 500-liter barrels. The wine was bottled with glass closures at the end of August 2012.
