CHARACTER

Deep dark ruby with an opaque core and purple highlights. Displays fresh rhubarb nuances with ethereal notes on the nose. Taut mineral character and fine-grained tannin on the palate. Finishes with red berries and juicy acidity.

ORIGIN

The grapes for this wine stem from both sides of Lake Neusiedl. One part comes from the Rosenberg a mica-schist dominated east-facing slope in Breitenbrunn on the Leitha Mountains. The other part comes from vineyards on the gravelly Parndorf Plain and the humus-rich Heideboden on the east side of the lake.

PRODUCTION

Bottled with conscientious handcraft and great care throughout the entire life cycle. Organic cultivation of the vineyards. Hand picked at the beginning of September 2012, spontaneous fermentation, two weeks on the skins in wooden vat and steel tank. 12 months maturation in used 500-litre oak barrels.
