Characteristics: Pale green-yellow. Slightly reductive bouquet with elderflower, gooseberry and dried wild meadow herbs. The palate exhibits subtle grapefruit zest, quince, and dried mint leaf that are highlighted by finely chiselled acidity and flow into salty mineral components that linger on the finish.

Origin: Vines of up to 30 years old in prime sites on the east slopes of the Leithagebirge: Kollern and Edelgraben vineyards in Breitenbrunn and the Alter Berg in Winden. All three sites are intensely marked by the typical fossil-rich limestone and calcareous sandstone of the region.

Vinification: Manual harvest mid September 2011 at 19.7° KMW (23.5° Brix). Hand selection in the vineyard was followed by a brief maceration with the stems and gentle pressing. Spontaneous fermentation and malolactic fermentation with 18 months maturation in large oak cask on the lees. Bottled unfiltered mid May 2013.
