## Weissburgunder Leithaberg<sup>DAC</sup> 2012

### CHARACTER

Medium green-yellow. Slightly reductive with nuances of fresh herbs over notes of white fruit. Full bodied, good complexity, subtle extract sweetness. Quite vibrant with salty mineral components on the long finish.

### ORIGIN

A wine from and with good perspectives. A Pinot Blanc with depth and focus derived from the fossil-rich calcareous sandstone and mica-slate soils on the east-facing slopes of the Leitha Mountains in Burgenland. Approximately 30-years-old vines grow in the *Kollern* and *Edelgraben* vineyards in Breitenbrunn and in the *Alten Berg* in Winden.

### PRODUCTION

Bottled with conscientious handcraft and great care throughout the entire life cycle. The vineyards are currently being converted to biodynamic cultivation. Hand picked mid-September and macerated overnight. Spontaneous and malolactic fermentation followed by 18 months maturation on the fine lees in large oak cask.
