## Weissburgunder Salzberg 2013

(PINOT BLANC)



### CHARACTER

Medium green-yellow. Persistent fragrance of stone fruit, apple, and white blossom. Multi-layered on the palate with ever-present hay flower, chamomile and, in particular, piquant salty notes. The path over the palate is paved with stones making a firm and sleek impression that remains ripe and juicy in texture. Vibrancy and vitality throughout.

### ORIGIN

This wine is a star on a great stage – the *Salzberg* in Gols. An exciting story told in only two very sun-exposed vine rows. The versatile repertoire that this *Weissburgunder* has to offer is based on sandy, calcareous loam.

### PRODUCTION

Bottled with conscientious handcraft and great care throughout the entire life cycle. The vineyards are cultivated according to the biodynamic regulations of the Respekt Vintners Association. Manually harvested in the beginning of September and macerated over night. Spontaneous alcoholic and malolactic fermentation. Matured for 18 months on the lees in used 500-litre oak barrels and bottled unfiltered.
