Characteristics: Dark ruby-garnet with an opaque core. Dark berries accompanied by subtle tobacco spice on the nose. Classic ripe cherry aroma with pleasant sweet fruit on the palate. Fine-boned tannin structure and appetizing character.

Origin: Vines of up to 30-years old that find their preferred conditions in the flat, low-lying sites east of Lake Neusiedl: deep, fertile cambisols, abundant sunshine, a unique microclimate that benefits from its proximity to the lake, and the superb 2012 vintage.

Vinification: Manual harvest mid-September 2012, hand selection in the vineyard followed by sorting in the winery. Movement of must occurs by gravitation without the use of pumps. Spontaneous fermentation, three weeks maceration and malolactic fermentation in stainless steel, maturation in large oak vats and used small oak barrels. Bottled at the beginning of December 2013.
