HEINRICH Zweigelt 2015 – 91 points

“This fresh, crunchy red shows ripe but balanced cherry notes. The nose is still restrained, but the palate delivers juicy, enlivening freshness with a pleasant grip. A fresh finish makes it very moreish.”

HEINRICH Blaufränkisch 2015 – 90 points

“This wine’s shy nose barely hints at black cherry and plum. The palate is taut and framed by smooth, finely woven tannins that still hold its juicy red fruit tight. A pleasant, fresh, aromatic grip lingers.”
